The tale of a boy, a girl and an ancient magic book - an insane love that unleashes demonic chaos into our world.

SYNOPSIS

Kai lives the average life of a teenage boy - bored at high-school, tired of his annoying girlfriend, fed up with his family - until one night at a party he meets and falls instantly in love with the wild, rebellious **Angithia**. Little does he realize the price this love will cost him, for the girl is a witch who has recently stolen the **Al Azif**, an ancient Sumerian magic book.

Soon enough, Angithia lures Kai into the art of **witchcraft** and the boy's safe and comfortable life shatters. After a disturbing series of blasphemous and perverse attempts at conjuration, they find themselves on the run; chased by the police for crimes they did not commit and haunted by a secret society of the Church who want to claim back the Al Azif.

And just to make things worse, the magic book is **curse**d, turning against anyone who is not strong enough to control it. Mysterious demons keep attacking the troubled lovers, and everyone they come in contact with goes insane. With unearthly powers let loose, Kai is caught in the middle - fighting a bitter battle on three sides - against the supernatural, the police and the Church. And even Angithia is not who she says she is...

Fleeing from the police, the Church and the demons, they end up in a **Cathedral** where Angithia conjures up holy powers to gain protection against the evil that pursues them. With the help of the Al Azif, her witchcraft is frighteningly powerful: not only keeping the demons safely outside, but also bewitching the police - the moment that the Special Forces enter the Cathedral, they go insane and massacre each other.

But Kai and Angithia don't have much time left. While they are inside the Cathedral struggling to understand the curse and to master the demons they have unleashed, outside the Cathedral a group of priests have become frustrated by the complete failure of the police and decide to take over. Led by the stern **Father Mordanno**, they attempt to infiltrate the Cathedral and stop the lovers.

Surrounded by madness and death, Kai starts having doubts - what if Angithia has only used him for some evil plan? Deceiving him and destroying his life, using him as a pawn in a much bigger game?

To find the answers, the boy has to face the most dreadful evil of all - the fear within.
